DEADLINE to submit abstracts – **31st of May**

GENERAL RULES

1. The presentation of papers is available only to participants in PMS;
2. Registration in *PMS* is mandatory for the author/co-author identified as the presenter;
3. All proposed communications will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee that will select those considered technically and scientifically accepted and may refuse abstracts that do not fit the standard quality;
4. On the day of the PMS the author(s) must ensure the availability of his works on paper, size A4, near the place of posting (s) Poster (s).
5. It will be issued one certificate for communication and which will include the author(s) co-author(s);
6. The Scientific Committee reserves the right to propose to the author(s) the presentation in the form of oral communication.

STANDARDS FOR THE ABSTRACT

- The abstract must cover the following topics
 - Introdução/Background
 - Objectivo/Aim
 - Material e Métodos/Material and Methods
 - Resultados/Results
 - Conclusão e Discussão/Conclusion and Discussion
 - Palavras-Chave/Keywords (minimum 3 and max 5)
 - Bibliografia/References

Standards for the Poster Presentation

Guidance for the authors

- Title in small and bold uppercase with size letters between 60-72 pts
- Name of the author(s) and affiliation
- Text of Topics in size letters between 48-52 pts
- Text in size letters between 24-28 pts
- Format Poster - 80 cm (horizontal) x 100 cm (vertical)
- The author/co-author, presenter will have 5 minutes to defend work
- The posters should be presented in Portuguese or English language
